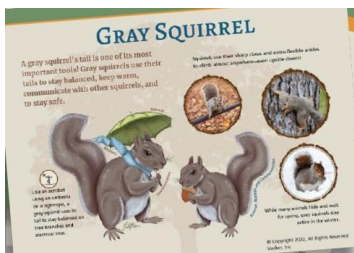

It is complete! You have a new walking trail and road to the canoe launch! So much work and effort went into applying for and finally receiving a grant to be able to construct this walking trail! The grant covered most of the cost and the balance was Act 13 funds! There are signs and benches along the walking trail. The walking trail is 3,542 feet which is 0.67 (2/3) miles. There will be new signs installed and enforced! Help to keep our Park nice! We hope that you enjoy it!

- No motorized vehicles are permitted on any grass or trails
(if you wish to take your pet to the creek, you must park and walk it down on a leash)
- Pets must be leashed

ROAD DOGS



Another great recipient of Act 13 monies is our roads! These monies allow us to repair more miles of Township roads every year! In 2026, we are hoping to be able to tar & chip approximately 9-10 miles!



Did you know that the township has no paved Township roads? All paved roads are state-owned. All township roads are tar & chip.



Therefore, salt cannot be used on them for winter maintenance. Salt makes our roads soft and deteriorates them. If you are salting your paved driveway, make sure it isn't melting onto a Township road or you will see the result!

We have already had a few decent snow storms. Hopefully, there aren't many more and winter will be behind us!



As summer approaches, salesmen begin going door to door trying to sell their wares. Please note that there is a No Soliciting Ordinance in Independence Township. Any solicitation, including religious, solar, paving, politics, menus, books, etc. are not permitted **WITHOUT** a permit. These permits enable our police department to vet these individuals and be aware of their vehicles in the Township. If anyone comes to your door, please ask them to see an **INDEPENDENCE TOWNSHIP** solicitation permit. If they do not have one, tell them to come to the office and apply for one.

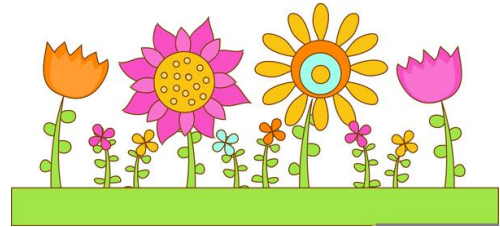
